IIT Delhi invites applications from qualified Indian Nationals, Persons of Indian Origin (PIOs) and Overseas Citizens of India (OCIs), who are exceptionally bright and motivated with an established record of independent, high quality research and commitment to teaching and research, for faculty positions at the level of Assistant Professor in various academic Departments/Centres/Schools.

DEPARTMENTS: Applied Mechanics, Biochemical Engineering & Biotechnology, Chemical Engineering, Chemistry, Civil Engineering, Computer Science & Engineering, Electrical Engineering, Humanities & Social Sciences, Management Studies, Mathematics, Mechanical Engineering, Physics, Textile Technology.

CENTRES: Applied Research in Electronics, Atmospheric Sciences, Biomedical Engineering, Energy Studies, Industrial Tribology Machine Dynamics & Maintenance Engineering, Instrument Design Development, Polymer Science & Engineering, Rural Development & Technology, Value Education in Engineering.

SCHOOLS: Bharti School of Telecommunication Technology and Management, Amar Nath & Shashi Khosla School of Information Technology.

QUALIFICATIONS: Ph.D. with first class or equivalent grade at the preceding degree in an appropriate branch/discipline with a very good academic record throughout.

EXPERIENCE: A minimum of three years industrial/research/teaching experience.

SCALE OF PAY: Rs. 12,000-420-18,300 per month plus allowances as admissible to Central Government employees stationed at Delhi.

AGE: The candidate should be preferably below 35 years of age.

NOTES:

- (i) There is a provision to waive the Ph.D. requirement for the post of Assistant Professor in (a) Architecture and Regional Planning, (b) Industrial Design; and (c) Medical Sciences and Technology.
- (ii) If it is felt necessary or desirable, appointment in a Centre or a School may be made on the basis of "Joint Appointment" with an appropriate Department.
- (iii) Minimum requirement of qualifications and/or experience may be relaxed in respect of exceptionally outstanding candidates in certain areas.**
- (iv) Mere fulfillment of qualifications and experience requirements do not entitle a candidate to be called for an interview.
- (v) The Institute reserves the right to fill or not to fill the posts advertised.

IIT Delhi makes all attempts to provide various support for professional advancement of faculty members. This includes:

1. Initial grant of up to Rs. 6.00 lakhs for research.
2. Air fare by Economy Class for joining the Institute from abroad subject to fulfilling prescribed conditions (this is under revision).
3. Full funding for attending one national conference per year either for presenting a paper or chairing a session.
4. Financial assistance up to Rs. 1.50 lakh once in 3 years for attending one International conference for presenting a paper or chairing a session as per Institute guidelines.

5. Reimbursement of 75% of membership fee of one international professional society.
6. Rs. 10,000/- per year as contingency grant for books, stationery, local travel, etc.
7. Reimbursement of telephone bills up to a ceiling of Rs. 750 per month.

Suitable residential accommodation as per rules shall be provided on the Campus of the Institute on joining the Institute.
