

Equivalence Certificate

The Consulate General of India, New York issues Equivalence Certificates to students based in its area of jurisdiction, who are currently studying in the United States school system, and are transferring to India to continue their education. The certificate is issued to students up to Grade 12.

The following documents may be submitted to the Consulate for issuing the Equivalence Certificate.

1. A request from the Parent/Guardian for issue of the certificate addressed to:

2. A copy of the School Transcript / Report card.
3. A copy of the High School Diploma certificate for students who have completed the 12th Grade.
4. A letter from the school, confirming the child's enrolment in that school.
5. A copy of the student's passport showing personal particulars and validity of visa and passport.
5. A US stamped self addressed envelope.
